<u>Today is the Feast of Christ the King,</u> a relatively recent addition to the liturgical calendar, instituted in 1925 by Pope Pius XI. In 1970 its Roman Catholic observance was moved to the final Sunday of Ordinary Time, this year falling on November 26<sup>th</sup>. Two of Pius XI other major contributions to history were the consecration of the first Chinese bishops and the doubling of the number of missionaries during his time as pope. If you are interested and like to read, there are many books on Pius XI's pontificate & life.
