

PASTORAL COLUMN

Dear parishioners of St. Elizabeth, St. Leonard, and Our Lady of Victory,

October is the month dedicated to The Most Holy Rosary. Many saints throughout the centuries attest to the power of praying the rosary. "The rosary is the weapon for these times" as Padre Pio told us. Yet many find the rosary to be a challenge to pray. Some find it dry and unfruitful while others find their mind wandering and thinking about everything else other than the rosary while praying it.

It's helpful to remember what we're doing when we pray the rosary. In praying the rosary we meditate on the mysteries of the life of Jesus Christ, God Himself, the second Person of the Trinity in the flesh. A question you can ask yourself when praying each decade of the rosary is "what is God revealing about himself in this mystery?" Then take it a step further and ask "what does that mean for my life?" There are infinite layers and unfathomable depth to each mystery that we continue to ponder a little more each time we pray the rosary.

Another fruitful method is to ponder each mystery from the different perspectives of those involved in each mystery. What was it like for Mary to receive the message from the angel Gabriel that she would be the mother of Jesus? What was it like for Gabriel to proclaim such a message? What was it like for the second Person of the Trinity to take on human flesh? May God bless us during this month of the rosary,
