

PASTORAL COLUMN

Dear parishioners of St. Elizabeth, St. Leonard, and Our Lady of Victory.

In the midst of our Advent prayer and reflection, we have a beautiful "synodal moment"...to enter and listen to one another, and the Holy Spirit, (with the help this weekend of Mary, Our Lady of Guadalupe) about some of the very important gifts and concerns of today's Church! The moment was created by my sickness on the morning of the First Sunday of Advent. Instead of a substitute priest, deacon and Mass as we are accustomed, the Holy Spirit provided the OLV community with a theologically and pastorally trained lay person from within the local congregation who led the "Sunday Eucharistic Celebration" in Absence of a Priest" (as the Church provides for). On short notice, Deb Forstner and the other liturgical ministers provided graceful leadership in prayer, and preaching (my homily notes!) for the community. Many people expressed their gratitude (and I am very grateful) that even without Mass, the Eucharist was still made available; some voiced distress at the absence of priest and Mass; a few did opt to leave when they realized what was happening, and perhaps looked for a Mass nearby. All responses and reactions are honored and valued. Now, in accord with our "season of synod"....What can this moment teach/tell us as Church, and about our future? About our love for the Eucharist? About vocations to the priesthood? About expanding ministries in the Church? About the Holy Spirit's movement among us? (and other process means Remember....the synodal questions...) LISTENING, HONORING, PRAYERFULLY PONDERING all voices, as we converse with others and within our own hearts. In these remaining Advent moments and days we pray COME, HOLY SPIRIT! Fr. Alan (P.S. it was a 48 hour flu bug and I tested negative for Covid.)


STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION
